The Tablas Creek Vineyard Virtual Wine Tasting will be hosted by the vineyard's manager and co-owner, Jason Haas. Jason's family has a direct Parkinson's connection and has been supportive of the Parkinson's Foundation for years. Tablas Creek is the realization of the combined efforts of two of the international wine community's leading families: the Perrin family, proprietors of Château de Beaucastel, and the Haas family of Vineyard Brands. Equally owned and run by the two families, the partnership begun in 1987 remains today as ever, even as the next generation of Haases and Perrins have stepped into leadership roles over recent decades. Tablas Creek led the effort to bring Rhone Valley wines to California and brought all of its root stock from Chateau de Beaucastel to Paso Robles. It is the first Regenerative Organic Certified Winery in the country and consistently receives outstanding reviews from professionals.

2017 Esprit de Tablas:

The Tablas Creek Vineyard 2017 Esprit de Tablas is a blend of four estate-grown varietals, propagated from budwood cuttings from the Château de Beaucastel estate. The wine is based on the dark red fruit, earth, spice and midpalate richness of Mourvèdre, with additions of Grenache for forward fruit, approachability and lushness, Syrah for mineral, aromatics, and back-palate tannins, and Counoise for brambly spice and acidity.

2018 Esprit de Tablas Blanc:

The Tablas Creek Vineyard 2018 Esprit de Tablas Blanc is our flagship white blend, chosen from the top lots of five estate-grown varietals propagated from budwood cuttings from the Château de Beaucastel estate. Roussanne provides the core richness, minerality, and flavors of honey and spice, while Grenache Blanc adds green apple and anise flavors, a lush mouthfeel and bright acids. Picpoul Blanc adds pineapple brightness and saline minerality. Picardan brings elegance while Clairette Blanche is crisp and gently citrusy.
