Leading off the reds from barrel, the 2015 Cote de Tablas is 39% Grenache, 35% Syrah and the rest Cunoise and Mourvedre. A pure, polished and textured red that offers lots of black currants, raspberries and peppery spice, drink this chewy, balanced and impressive red on release and over the following 4-6 years.
