Tasted out of foudre

Tasted out of foudre, the 2013 Roussanne should be outstanding. A wine that will see 18 months in foudre, it's being treated more and more like a red wine in the winery. Showing beautiful aromatics of ripe peaches and tropical fruits, white flowers, subtle toast and licorice, this beauty flows onto the palate with medium to full-bodied richness, integrated acidity and a clean, focused finish. It will have 4-5 years (or more) of longevity.
