



2015 Tablas Creek- Esprit de Tablas

Possessing the most Mourvedre since 2004, the 2015 Esprit de Tablas (40% Mourvedre, 28% Syrah, 22% Grenache and 10% Counoise) is a serious looking barrel sample. Offering lots of floral characteristics, medium to full-bodied richness, a layered, silky, seamless texture and plenty of white pepper, violets and darker berry fruit aromas and flavors, I suspect it could shut down quickly (given all of the Mourvedre), yet evolve for 10-15 years or more.
