

2013 Tablas Creek Esprit de Tablas

The 2013 Esprit de Tablas checks in as a blend of 40% Mourvedre, 28% Syrah, 22% Grenache and 10% Counoise that will see 22 months in foudre prior to bottling. It shows impressive blackberry, raspberry and cherry pit like nuances to go with plenty of roasted herbs, licorice and hints of spring flowers. Medium to full-bodied, rich and with big bones, it should continue to fill in nicely once in bottle and have upward of a decade of longevity.
