They remind me of their counterparts in many of the more hands-on, family run areas in Europe such as the Rhône Valley, Burgundy, Piedmont, and Alto Adige. So many are 'down to earth' with their feet firmly planted in their vineyards."

## **TABLAS CREEK VINEYARD**



"ESPRIT DE BEAUCASTEL BLANC 2009 SCORE 94 Aromas of Brazilian limes and lemon with flowers. Lemon curd. Rich. Full-bodied, with wonderful dense and agile palate of dried apples, mango and figs. Love the finish. Caramel, honey and lemons. Roussanne really comes out. 62% Roussanne, 26% Grenache Blanc and 12% Picpoul Blanc. Drink now or hold.

**ESPRIT DE BEAUCASTEL PANOPLIE 2008** SCORE **94** This is a layered red with firm and silky tannins with dark berries and minerals with hints of flowers. Full yet racy and refined. Very long and beautiful. 54% Mourvèdre, 29% Grenache, and 17% Syrah. This needs another two to three years of bottle age to soften. The Mourvèdre makes it.

**EN GOBELET 2009** SCORE **93** This is a blend of all dry farmed head pruned grapes; hence Gobelet in French. Full-bodied, yet balanced and refined with plenty of subtle fruit and a wet earth, spice and berry character. 56% Mourvèdre, 23% Tannat, and 21% Grenache. Drink now or hold.

**ESPRIT DE BEAUCASTEL 2009** SCORE **93** A wine that shows a beautiful balance of dark fruits, spices and hints of herbs. Full body yet refined and balanced with refined tannins and a fresh finish. Made from 40% Mourvèdre, 27% Syrah, 27% Grenache and 5% Counoise. Drink or hold.

**CÔTES DE TABLAS BLANC 2010**SCORE **92**Bright and fruity with a floral character of gardenias and dried mangos. Full yet balanced and crisp. Loads of flavor. 54% Viognier, 30% Grenache Blanc, 8% Marsanne, and 8% Roussanne. Screwcap. Drink now.

**GRENACHE BLANC 2010** SCORE **92** Lots of Grenache blanc character with peach skin, blanched almonds, chalk and citrus. Full and fresh with a long, subtle and complex aftertaste. Drink now.

**PICPOUL BLANC 2010**SCORE **91**Fascinating character of sliced peached, lemons and minerals with a chalky undertone. Full and subtle yet flavorful and intense. Lots going on here. I have only had this from a vat in Châteauneuf before blending. Like it very much here in bottle. Drink now.

**ESPRIT DE BEAUCASTEL 2008** SCORE **91** A subtle and delicate wine with subtle chocolate, berry and spices on the nose and palate. Lovely length and balance. 38% Mourvèdre, 30% Grenache, 27% Syrah, and 6% Counoise. Drink now or hold.

MARSANNE 2010 SCORE 90 Oily and rich with plenty of mango and pineapple character. Full and fruity with a long flavorful finish. Screwcap. Drink now.

**VERMENTINO 2010** SCORE **90** I like the almond and apple character with hints of chalk. Full body, with good fruit and a flowery. Tangy acidity. Lots of bright fruit. Screwcap. Drink now.

**PATELIN DE TABLAS 2010**SCORE **90**This is the first vintage of this wine which is from bought grapes from neighbors with some from Tablas Creek too. Full to medium body, with lovely clean fruit and a long silky finish. Firm tannins. Little or no wood. Like the touch of austerity to this. 39% Syrah, 36% Grenache, 22% Mourvèdre, and 3% Counoise. Screwcap. Drink now."
