Vermentino 2018

95 points

“Brilliant, light gold/green color. The aromatics are very intense offering scents of grapefruit and tropical fruits with supporting notes of lemongrass, citrus zest, and honeysuckle. The palate confirms the nose delivering a green fruit-driven core with flavors of green melon, white peach, slate, and hints of fresh herbs. The finish is long and lingering. Medium-bodied and perfectly balanced with a vibrant yet generous texture. Made with 100% Vermentino. A perennial favorite here at BevX.”

Roussanne 2016

94 points

“Brilliant, medium golden color. The aromatics are very intense offering scents of tropical fruit and honey with supporting notes of blanched almonds, oak, and candied ginger. The palate confirms the nose delivering a tropical fruits-driven core with flavors of bees wax, pineapple, and jasmine. The finish is long and lingering. Medium to full-bodied and perfectly balanced with a opulent texture. This is our favorite Tablas Creek Roussanne to date.”

Patelin de Tablas Rosé 2018

93 points

“Brilliant, light peach color. The nose is moderately intense offering scents of nectarine and wet stones with supporting notes of strawberry, mineral, and red grapefruit. The palate echoes the nose delivering a red fruit-driven core with flavors of orange peel, pomegranate, and raspberry. The finish is long and lingering with hints of rose petals. Medium-bodied and perfectly balanced with a vibrant texture. Made with a blend of 76% Grenache, 20% Mourvèdre, and 4% Counoise.”

Dianthus Rosé 2018

94 points

“Brilliant, medium salmon color. The nose is moderately intense offering scents of strawberry and sweet rhubarb with supporting notes of watermelon, wet stones, and jasmine. The palate echoes the nose delivering a red fruit-driven core with flavors of raspberry and kumquat. The finish is long and lingering with tart red fruits and very subtle tannins. Medium-bodied and perfectly balanced with a substantial yet vibrant texture. Made with a blend of 51% Mourvèdre, 39% Grenache, and 10% Counoise. This is a meaty Rosé with guts and charm to spare.”

Patelin de Tablas 2017

91 points

“Brilliant, deep ruby color. The aromatics are very intense offering scents of blackberry and black tea with supporting notes of five spice, forest floor, mineral, and dried herbs. The palate echoes the nose delivering a black fruit-driven core with flavors of black currant, plum, and star anise. The finish is long and lingering with ripe tannins. Medium to full-bodied and nicely balanced with a supple texture. Made with a blend of 48% Syrah, 32% Grenache, 16% Mourvèdre, and 4% Counoise.”
