## TABLAS CREEK

Côtes de Tablas Paso Robles 2009 93 \$30 CALIFORNIA

This Châteauneuf-du-Pape-style red blend has lived in the shadow of the winery's more expensive Esprit de Beaucastel, but this year it outranked its stablemate, earning its best review to date. With the Perrin family of Château de Beaucastel as a key partner, Tablas Creek has perfected a uniquely Californian take on the Rhône Valley. Grenache accounts for nearly half of the blend, along with Syrah, Counoise and Mourvèdre, fermented in both stainless steel and wood. The wine was aged in 1,200-gallon French oak casks. 1,050 cases made.

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ducer of quality-for-value wines, in 2007. The change in ownership and a new winemaking team led by Sam Tannahill, Cheryl Francis and Michael Davies is already paying off, with the overall quality of the wines on the rise. Davies used purchased and estate grapes from all seven of Willamette Valley's appellations in this red, the winery's entry level Pinot, to produce a wine that is powerful yet elegant. 6,162 cases made.

After a long career in the wine industry, winemaker Ron Coleman and his wife, Jamie, founded their own winery in 1998. The couple found space in a restored World War II firehouse near the Walla Walla airport, Tamarack's wines consistently rate very good to outstanding, but it raised the quality level with its 2007 Cabernet, its highest rated vet. Coleman blended 86 percent Cabernet with Merlot and Cabernet Franc from vineyards throughout eastern Washington. 1,064 cases made.

rdonnay Napa Valley ate Reserve 2009 \$37 CALIFORNIA

Beringer is doing something right—its Private Reserve Chardonnay is the only white wine ever to be crowned Wine of the Year, in 1996, and with the exception of two vintages it has rated outstanding since the 1992 vintage. The 2009 comes mostly from Gamble Ranch. near the town of Yountville. Winemaker Laurie Hook fermented the pressed juice in 76 percent new French oak barrels and stirred the lees weekly to create a rich wine with just the right touch of oak, 12,500 cases made.
