- Made from grapes selected entirely from head-trained blocks of our vineyard.

56% Mourvèdre

23% Tannat

21% Grenache

- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

A dark nose showing menthol, black cherry and mineral, flavors of bittersweet chocolate, leather, mesquite, and rare steak, with a lingering finish of garrigue and black fruit.
