- A traditional blend of Southern Rhône varietals:

64% Mourvèdre 28% Grenache 8% Counoise

- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.
- Rich, ripe and full of fruit, with aromatics of white plum and flavors of ripe strawberries balanced by fresh acidity and a lingering finish. A serious wine for all seasons.
