- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands.
- Vermentino is a traditional Mediterranean grape; in the Rhône valley, it is known as Rolle.
- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

 A clean, mineral nose of lime and pear, with no influence of oak.
 Flavors of green apple and lime in the mouth, with refreshing acidity and a lingering finish.
