CÔTES de TABLAS BLANC 2004

- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands.
- A traditional blend of Southern Rhône varietals:

55% Viognier 29% Marsanne 8% Grenache Blanc 8% Roussanne

- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

Marries the aromatics of Viognier, the minerality of Marsanne, and the richness and firm acids of Roussanne and Grenache Blanc. Aromas of herbs and stone fruits are followed by flavors of apricot and citrus, rich texture and a clean, peachy finish.
