- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands.
- Mourvèdre is a traditional Châteauneuf-du-Pape varietal renowned for its red fruit nose, meaty, earthy flavors, and structure and ageability.
- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

A classic nose of roasted meats, plums and spice. Juicy and full in the mouth, it features lingering notes of plum, currant, coffee, chocolate and leather, with a long mineral finish.
