- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands.
- Grenache Blanc is the most widely planted white grape in the Rhône Valley, noted for its crisp acidity, rich mouthfeel, and flavors of apple and citrus.
- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

Pale gold, with aromas of lemon and anise. Flavors of green apple and marzipan are balanced by bright acids and a long, elegant lemon drop finish.
