- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands.
- A traditional rosé blend of Southern Rhône varietals:

57% Mourvèdre
31% Grenache
12% Counoise

- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

Rich, ripe and full of fruit, with aromatics of white plum, provençal herbs, and flavors of ripe strawberries balanced by fresh acidity, and a lingering finish. A serious wine for all seasons.
