- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands.
- Grenache is the most widely planted grape in the Rhône Valley, producing wines notable for fruit, spice and acidity.
- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Adelaida District of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- Estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

A bright, fruity nose of red and blue fruits, flavors of blueberry and cherry cola, a creamy texture, and a finish with bright acids that frame the fruit, spice and minerality.
