- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

A rich nose of dark chocolate, mint, leather, and crushed rock, explosive flavors of dark cherry with chalky Grenache tannins, and a long finish with licorice, spice and cherry liqueur.
