- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands.
- A traditional rosé blend of Southern Rhône varietals:

59% Mourvèdre

30% Grenache

11% Counoise

- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

An explosive nose of red chile jam, plum, mineral and spice. Flavors of watermelon and tart cherry, with bright acids and a long finish with echoes of lime and tangerine.
