- *California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel in Châteauneuf-du-Pape, France.*
- *Vines of Tablas Creek Vineyard originated from Beaucastel.*
- *Grown on chalky clay soils of the same geologic origin as those in Châteauneuf-du-Pape.*
- *Organically farmed vineyard.*
- *Wines produced from grapes grown exclusively on our estate.*
- *Fermented using its native yeasts.*
- *A traditional blend of Southern Rhône varietal grapes:*
 - 40% Mourvèdre**
 - 27% Grenache Noir**
 - 23% Syrah**
 - 10% Counoise**
- *Reserve Cuvée 1999 is deeply colored, richly intense, highly extracted wine, redolent of ripe cherries, raspberries, currants and blueberries held together in a velvety tannic structure.*
- *Limited production of 2208 cases.*
